

How to Self-Enroll in the Best Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan for 2022

This process is specifically suited for people who have Medicare Supplement Insurance such as plan N, G or F.

We strongly advise that if you are currently on a Medicare Advantage Plan such as Health Alliance, Regence Blue Shield, or AARP Medicare Advantage HMO plan that you **DO NOT** use this process!!!...contact us directly if you want us to review your plan.

IMPORTANT!! If you have Medicare Advantage and use the below process you will be disenrolled from your ENTIRE Medicare Advantage plan effective 1/1/2022!!

THIS PROCESS IS VERY INTUATIVE. MANY OF YOU CAN GET BY WITHOUT THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW. However, we list them as a help for those who feel more comfortable with them.

Step 1: Go to www.seniorsolutions.net and select "2022 Part D - Drug Enrollment Resources" blue button on the homepage.

Step 2: Click on "Drug Plan Part D – Self Enroll" green button. Enter your PHYSICAL Address zip code, not PO BOX. You can then click "view plans" – **very important, click Prescription Drug Plans (the third tab over).**

Step 3: On the left side, under preferences, click add prescriptions. You can now add your prescriptions and then click "continue" after they are all entered. Then, enter your pharmacy. (If you don't see your pharmacy and it's a chain like Walmart, Walgreens, Safeway etc., put in either zip code 98902 or 98901 and most will populate as it doesn't have to be the actual location you use).

Step 4: Click continue and you will see the plans in order by total cost effectiveness for 2022.

Step 5: Once you have reviewed the plan, you can click the orange "add to cart" button then click the orange "continue to apply" button.

Step 6: Fill out the enrollment forms. Have your Medicare card available, leave the dashes out when you enter it. Take your time, accuracy is important. The enrollment form is very straightforward. It will advise you if you need to correct anything undone automatically. **When finished click "submit".**

Step 7: Now you are done. **Medicare will automatically disenroll you from your current Drug Plan for 1/1/2022.** You will get a confirmation to your email if you entered one. Also, if you DON'T get your new plan materials within a few weeks, please contact us BEFORE 12/01/2021!!
